Mathematics

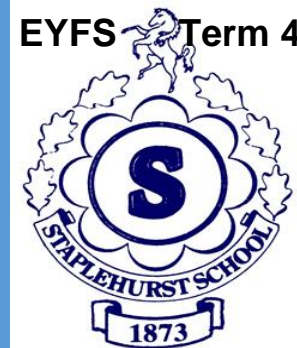
We will be learning to...

- count objects, actions and sounds
- compare numbers
- link numerals to cardinal number values
- understand the one more/one less than relationship between consecutive numbers
- explore the composition of numbers to 10
- automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-5 and some to 10
- continue, copy and create repeating patterns
- select, rotate and manipulate shapes to develop our special reasoning skills
- compose and decompose shapes to recognise shapes within shapes (3D shapes)
