PSHE

Economic wellbeing

This term the children will be considering:

- Feelings about money.
- How to keep money safe.
- Financial futures.
- Workplace environments and career routes.

Maths

Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

- Adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions and decimals
- Finding fractions and percentages of amounts
- Converting between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Measurement, Perimeter and Volume

- Find the area of irregular shapes, triangles parallelograms and trapeziums.
- Calculating volume

Computing

This term children will build on their coding learning to write their own text adventures . Their learning will focus on:

- Designing and making a story-based adventure game
- Coding using a map

Swimming

In addition to their PE provision, this term the children will be learning to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 meters
- Use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, back-stroke and breaststroke]
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

Science

- This term we will be learning about light. Children will learn to:
- recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines and to use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them
